The new **Small Herd Initiative** helps farmers like you keep livestock out of streams. Starting July 1, you can receive up to \$50,000 for best practices — plus ongoing technical assistance, **tailored to your farm and your priorities**.

The practices benefit your farm, promoting:

- Lower rates of animal injury and disease.
- Greater weight gain in cattle, plus higher quality and quantity of milk produced.
- Less soil loss from stream bank erosion.

Instead of the usual 55-75% reimbursement caps for most stream-exclusion practices, the Small Herd Initiative pays up to 100% for:

- Stream exclusion with buffer and grazing land management
- · Stream protection fencing with buffer
- Portable fencing
