- Town of Onley – Implementation of Phase I Program found Compliant
- City of Chesapeake – Implementation of Phase I Program found Compliant
- Essex County – Implementation of Phase I Program found Compliant
- Town of Parksley – Implementation of Phase I Program found Compliant
- King George County – Implementation of Phase I Program found Compliant
- Town of Bloxom – Implementation of Phase I Program found Not Fully Compliant. The Town was given an April 15, 2009 deadline to address one condition
- Town of Melfa – Implementation of Phase I Program found Not Fully Compliant. The Town was given an April 15, 2009 deadline to address one condition
- City of Norfolk – Implementation of Phase I Program found Not Fully Compliant. The City was given a June 30, 2009 deadline to address one condition
- City of Petersburg – Implementation of Phase I Program found Not Fully Compliant. The City was given a March 24, 2009 deadline to address seven conditions, a March 31, 2010 deadline to address one condition, and one condition to be addressed in a manner and timeline approved by the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board.
- City of Virginia Beach – Implementation of Phase I Program found Non Compliant. The County was given a final deadline of April 30, 2009 to address one condition
