5 Fees

6 **4VAC50-60-700. Purpose.**

7 Sections 10.1-603.4 and 10.1-603.5 of the Code of Virginia authorize the
8 establishment of a statewide fee schedule, including administrative charges for state
9 agencies, for stormwater management and state agency projects for land-disturbing
10 activities and for municipal separate storm sewer systems. These regulations in this This
11 part establish establishes the fee assessment and the collection system and distribution
12 systems for those fees. The fees associated with individual permits or coverage under
13 the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater From Construction Activities (permits
14 for stormwater management for land-disturbing activities) issued by a qualifying local
15 program or a department-administered local stormwater management program that has
16 been approved by the board shall include costs associated with plan review, permit
17 review and issuance, inspections, enforcement, program administration and oversight,
18 and database management. Fees shall also be established for permit maintenance,
19 modification, and transfer.

20 Should a qualifying local program demonstrate to the board its ability to fully and
21 successfully implement a qualifying local program without a full implementation of the
22 fees set out in this part, the board may authorize the administrative establishment of a
23 lower fee for that program provided that such reduction shall not reduce the amount of
24 fees due to the department for its program oversight and shall not affect the fee
25 schedules set forth herein.

26 A qualifying local program may establish greater fees than those base fees specified
27 by this part should it be demonstrated to the board that such greater fees are necessary
28 to properly administer the qualifying local program. Any fee increases established by the
29 qualifying local program beyond those base fees established in this part shall not be
30 subject to the fee distribution formula set out in 4VAC50-60-780. Nothing in this part
31 shall prohibit a locality from establishing other local fees authorized by the Code of
32 Virginia related to stormwater management within their jurisdictions.

33 As part of its program oversight, the department shall periodically assess the
34 revenue generated by both the localities and the department to ensure that the fees
35 have been appropriately set and the fees may be adjusted through periodic regulatory
36 actions should significant deviations become apparent. The department may make such
37 periodic adjustments in addition to the annual fee increases authorized by 4VAC50-60-
38 840.

39 **4VAC50-60-710. Definitions. (Repealed.)**

40 The following words and terms used in this chapter have the following meanings:

41 "Permit applicant" means for the purposes of this part any person submitting a permit
42 application for issuance, reissuance, or modification, except as exempted by 4VAC50-
43 60-740, of a permit or filing a registration statement or permit application for coverage
44 under a general permit issued pursuant to the Act and this chapter.

45 "Permit application" means for the purposes of this part the forms approved by the
46 Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board for applying for issuance or reissuance of a
47 permit or for filing a registration statement or application for coverage under a general
48 permit issued in response to the Act and this chapter. In the case of modifications to an

49 existing permit requested by the permit holder and not exempted by 4VAC50-60-740,
50 the application shall consist of the formal written request and any accompanying
51 documentation submitted by the permit holder to initiate the modification.

52 **4VAC50-60-720. Authority.**

53 The authority for this part is pursuant to ~~§§ 10.1-604.4~~ §§ 10.1-603.4 and 10.1-
54 603.4:1 of the Code of Virginia and enactment clause 7 governing the transfer of the
55 relevant provisions of Fees for Permits and Certificates Regulations, 9VAC25-20, in
56 accordance with Chapter 372 of the 2004 Virginia Acts of Assembly.

57 **4VAC50-60-730. Applicability.**

58 A. This part applies to:

59 1. All ~~permit applicants for issuance of~~ persons seeking coverage of a MS4 under
60 a new permit or reissuance of an existing permit, except as specifically exempt
61 under 4VAC50-60-740 A. The fee due shall be as specified under 4VAC50-60-
62 800 ~~or 4VAC50-60-820.~~

63 2. All ~~permittees operators~~ who request that an existing MS4 individual permit be
64 modified, except as specifically exempt under 4VAC50-60-740 A 1 of this
65 chapter. The fee due shall be as specified under 4VAC50-60-810.

66 3. All persons seeking coverage under the General Permit for Discharges of
67 Stormwater From Construction Activities or a person seeking an Individual Permit
68 for Discharges of Stormwater From Construction Activities. The fee due shall be
69 as specified under 4VAC50-60-820.

70 4. All permittees who request modifications to or transfers of their existing
71 registration statement for coverage under a General Permit for Discharges of
72 Stormwater From Construction Activities or of an Individual Permit for Discharges
73 of Stormwater From Construction Activities. The fee due shall be as specified
74 under 4VAC50-60-825 in addition to any additional fees necessary pursuant to
75 4VAC50-60-820 due to an increase in acreage.

76 B. An applicant for a permit involving a permit that is to be revoked and
77 reissued Persons who are applicants for an individual VSMP Municipal Separate
78 Stormwater Sewer System permit as a result of existing permit revocation shall be
79 considered an applicant for a new permit. The fee due shall be as specified under
80 4VAC50-60-800.

81 Persons whose coverage under the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater
82 From Construction Activities has been revoked shall reapply for an Individual Permit for
83 Discharges of Stormwater From Construction Activities. The fee due shall be as
84 specified under 4VAC50-60-820.

85 C. Permit and permit coverage maintenance fees may apply to each Virginia
86 Stormwater Management Permit Program (VSMP) permit holder. The fee due shall be
87 as specified under 4VAC50-60-830.

88 **4VAC50-60-740. Exemptions.**

89 A. No permit application fees will be assessed to:

90 1. Permittees who request minor modifications ~~or minor amendments~~ to permits
91 as defined in 4VAC50-60-10 or other minor amendments at the discretion of the
92 local stormwater management program.

93 2. Permittees whose permits are modified or amended at the initiative of the
94 permit-issuing authority. This does not include errors in the registration statement

95 identified by the local stormwater management program or errors related to the
96 acreage of the site.

97 B. Permit modifications at the request of the permittee resulting in changes to
98 stormwater management plans that require additional review by the local stormwater
99 management program shall not be exempt pursuant to this section and shall be subject
100 to fees specified under 4VAC50-60-825.

101 **4VAC50-60-750. Due dates for Virginia Stormwater Management Program (VSMP)**
102 **Permits.**

103 ~~A. Permit application fees for all new permit applications are due on the day a permit~~
104 ~~application is submitted and shall be~~ Requests for a permit, permit modification, or
105 general permit coverage shall not be processed until the fees required pursuant to this
106 part are paid in accordance with 4VAC50-60-760. Applications will not be processed
107 without payment of the required fee.

108 ~~B. A permit application fee is due on the day a permit application is submitted for a~~
109 ~~major modification that occurs (and becomes effective) before the stated permit~~
110 ~~expiration date. There is no application fee for a major modification or amendment that is~~
111 ~~made at the permit-issuing authority's initiative.~~

112 ~~C. Permit~~ B. Individual permit or general permit coverage maintenance fees shall be
113 paid annually to the permit-issuing authority by October 1 of each year ~~department or the~~
114 qualifying local program, as applicable, by the anniversary date of individual permit
115 issuance or general permit coverage. No permit will be reissued or automatically
116 continued without payment of the required fee. Individual permit or general permit
117 coverage maintenance fees shall be applied until a Notice of Termination is effective.

118 MS4 individual operators who currently pay a permit maintenance fee that is due by
119 October 1 of each year shall continue to pay the maintenance fee by October 1 until their
120 current permit expires. Upon reissuance of the MS4 individual permit, maintenance fees
121 shall be paid on the anniversary date of the reissued permit.

122 ~~Effective April 1, 2005, any permit holder whose permit is effective as of April 1 of a~~
123 ~~given year (including permits that have been administratively continued) shall pay the~~
124 ~~permit maintenance fee or fees to the permit-issuing authority by October 1 of that same~~
125 ~~year.~~

126 **4VAC50-60-760. Method of payment.**

127 ~~A. Fees, as applicable, shall be, at the discretion of the department, submitted~~
128 ~~electronically or be paid by check, draft or postal money order payable to:~~

129 ~~the~~ 1. The Treasurer of Virginia, for a MS4 individual or general permit or for a
130 coverage issued by the department under the General Permit for Discharges of
131 Stormwater From Construction Activities or Individual Permit for Discharges of
132 Stormwater From Construction Activities, to the permit-issuing authority, and
133 must be in U.S. currency, except that agencies and institutions of the
134 Commonwealth of Virginia may submit Interagency Transfers for the amount of
135 the fee. To pay electronically, go to the Department of Conservation and
136 Recreation's stormwater management section of the Department's public website
137 at <http://www.dcr.virginia.gov>. The Department of Conservation and Recreation
138 may provide a means to pay fees electronically. Fees not submitted electronically

142 2. The qualifying local program, for coverage authorized by the qualifying local
143 program under the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater From
144 Construction Activities, and must be in U.S. currency.

145 B. Required information - for permits or permit coverage: All applicants ~~for new~~
146 ~~permit issuance, permit reissuance, or permit modification, unless otherwise specified by~~
147 the department, shall submit the following information along with the fee payment or
148 utilize the Department of Conservation and Recreation Permit Application Fee Form:

- 149 1. Applicant name, address and daytime phone number.
- 150 2. Applicant Federal Identification Number (FIN), if applicable.
- 151 3. The name of the facility/activity, and the facility/activity location.
- 152 4. The type of permit applied for.
- 153 5. Whether the application is for a new permit issuance, permit reissuance,
154 permit maintenance, or permit modification.
- 155 6. The amount of fee submitted.
- 156 7. The existing permit number, if applicable.
- 157 8. Other information as required by the local stormwater management program.

158 **4VAC50-60-770. Incomplete payments and late payments.**

159 All incomplete payments will be deemed as nonpayments. The department or the
160 qualifying local program, as applicable, shall provide notification to the applicant of any
161 incomplete payments.

162 Interest may be charged for late payments at the underpayment rate ~~set out by the~~
163 ~~U.S. Internal Revenue Service established pursuant to § 6621(a)(2) of the Internal~~
164 ~~Revenue Code. This rate is prescribed~~ set forth in § 58.1-15 of the Code of Virginia and
165 is calculated on a monthly basis at the applicable periodic rate.

166 A 10% late payment fee ~~may~~ shall be charged to any delinquent (over 90 days past
167 due) account.

168 The ~~permit-issuing authority is~~ department and the qualifying local program are
169 entitled to all remedies available under the Code of Virginia in collecting any past due
170 amount ~~and may recover any attorney's fees and/or other administrative costs incurred~~
171 ~~in pursuing and collecting any past due amount.~~

172 **4VAC50-60-780. Deposit and use of fees.**

173 A. All fees collected by the ~~board~~ department or department board in
174 response pursuant to this chapter shall be deposited into a ~~special nonreverting fund~~
175 ~~known as the Virginia Stormwater Management Fund established by,~~ shall be used
176 and accounted for as specified in § 10.1-603.4:1 of the Code of Virginia. Fees
177 collected by the department or board shall be exempt from statewide indirect costs
178 charged and collected by the Department of Accounts.

179 B. All fees collected by a qualifying local program pursuant to this chapter shall be
180 subject to accounting review and shall be used solely to carry out the qualifying local
181 program's responsibilities pursuant to Part II and Part III A of this chapter.

182 Whenever Pursuant to subdivision 5 a of § 10.1-603.4 of the Code of Virginia,
183 whenever the board has delegated authorized the administration of a stormwater
184 management program to by a locality or is required to do so by the Act qualifying local

185 ~~program, no more than 30%~~ 28% of the total revenue generated by the statewide
186 stormwater management fees collected within the locality in accordance with 4VAC50-
187 60-820 shall be remitted on a monthly basis to the State Treasurer for deposit in the
188 Virginia Stormwater Management Fund unless otherwise collected electronically. If the
189 qualifying local program waives or reduces any fee due in accordance with 4VAC50-60-
190 820, the qualifying local program shall remit the 28% portion that would be due to the
191 Virginia Stormwater Management Fund if such fee were charged in full. Any fee
192 increases established by the qualifying local program beyond the base fees established
193 in this part shall not be subject to the fee distribution formula.

194 **4VAC50-60-790. General.**

195 ~~Each permit application for a new permit each permit application for reissuance of a~~
196 ~~permit, each permit application for major modification of a permit, and each revocation~~
197 ~~and reissuance of a permit is a~~ The fees for individual permits, general permit coverage,
198 permit or registration statement modification, or permit transfers are considered
199 separate action actions and shall be assessed a separate fee, as applicable. The fees
200 for each type of permit that the permit-issuing authority has the authority to issue,
201 reissue or modify will be as specified in this part.

202 **4VAC50-60-800. Fee schedules for VSMP Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System**
203 **new permit issuance.**

204 The following fee schedule applies to permit applications for issuance of a
205 new individual VSMP Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System permit or coverage
206 under a MS4 General Permit. All regulated MS4s that apply for joint coverage under an
207 individual permit or general permit registration shall each pay the appropriate fees set
208 out below.

VSMP Municipal Stormwater / MS4 Individual (Large and Medium)	\$21,300 <u>\$16,000</u>
VSMP Municipal Stormwater / MS4 Individual (Small)	\$2,000 <u>\$8,000</u>

220 The following fees apply to ~~filing of permit applications (registration statements) for~~
221 ~~all general permits issued by the permit-issuing authority, except VSMP Stormwater~~
222 ~~Construction General Permits~~ coverage under the General Permit for Discharges of
223 Stormwater from Construction Activities issued by the department prior to a qualifying

224 local program or a department-administered local stormwater management program
 225 being approved by the board in the area where the applicable land-disturbing activity is
 226 located, or where the department has issued an individual permit or coverage under the
 227 General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction Activities for a state or
 228 federal agency for which it has approved annual standards and specifications.

229 The fee for filing a permit application (registration statement) for coverage under a
 230 VSMP stormwater general permit issued by the permit-issuing authority shall be:

231 The following fees apply to coverage under the General Permit for Discharges of
 232 Stormwater from Construction Activities for a state or federal agency that does not file
 233 annual standards and specifications, an individual permit issued by the board or
 234 coverage under the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction
 235 Activities issued by a qualifying local program, or a department-administered local
 236 stormwater management program that has been approved by the board. For coverage
 237 under the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction Activities, no
 238 more than 50% of the base fee set out in this part shall be due at the time that a
 239 stormwater management plan or an initial stormwater management plan is submitted for
 240 review in accordance with 4VAC50-60-108. The remaining 50% base fee balance shall
 241 be due prior to the issuance of coverage under the General Permit for Discharges of
 242 Stormwater from Construction Activities.

243 When a site or sites are purchased for development within a previously permitted
 244 common plan of development or sale, the applicant shall be subject to fees in
 245 accordance with the disturbed acreage of their site or sites according to the following
 246 table.

247 **4VAC50-60-825. Fees for the modification or transfer of individual permits or of**
248 **registration statements for the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from**
249 **Construction Activities.**

250 The following fees apply to modification or transfer of individual permits or of
251 registration statements for the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from
252 Construction Activities issued by a qualifying local program or a department-
253 administered local stormwater management program that has been approved by the
254 board. If the permit modifications result in changes to stormwater management plans
255 that require additional review by the local stormwater management program, such
256 reviews shall be subject to the fees set out in this section. The fee assessed shall be
257 based on the total disturbed acreage of the site. In addition to the permit modification
258 fee, modifications resulting in an increase in total disturbed acreage shall pay the
259 difference in the initial permit fee paid and the permit fee that would have applied for the
260 total disturbed acreage in 4VAC50-60-820. No modification or transfer fee shall be
261 required until such board-approved programs exist. No modification fee shall be required
262 for the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction Activities for a
263 state or federal agency that is administering a project in accordance with approved

264 annual standards and specifications but shall apply to all other state or federal agency
 265 projects.

266 **4VAC50-60-830. Permit maintenance fees.**

267 A. The following annual permit maintenance fees apply to each VSMP permit
 268 identified below, including expired permits that have been administratively continued.
 269 With respect to the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction
 270 Activities, these fees shall apply until the permit coverage is terminated, and shall only
 271 be effective when assessed by a qualifying local program or a department-administered
 272 local stormwater management program that has been approved by the board. No
 273 maintenance fee shall be required for a General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater

274 from Construction Activities until such board approved programs exist. No maintenance
 275 fee shall be required for the General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from
 276 Construction Activities for a state or federal agency that is administering a project in
 277 accordance with approved annual standards and specifications but shall apply to all
 278 other state or federal agency projects. All regulated MS4s who are issued joint coverage
 279 under an individual permit or general permit registration shall each pay the appropriate
 280 fees set out below:
