As sea levels rise and climate change causes more significant and frequent weather events, Virginia must increase its resilience to sea level rise, flooding, and natural hazards. To address this growing risk for the Commonwealth and its citizens, Governor Ralph S. Northam signed Executive Order 24- Increasing Virginia's Resilience To Sea Level Rise And Natural Hazards on November 2, 2018. This executive order provides a pathway to increased resilience to these hazards in the Commonwealth and includes a provision for the Commonwealth's first Coastal Resilience Master Plan, with the goal of aligning state efforts and assisting local governments in reducing flood risk through planning and implementing large-scale flood protection and adaptation initiatives.
