## **BLUEBIRD NESTING GUIDE**

## **FIRST NEST**

- Female starts building nest first part of April.
- Usually builds nest in 3-4 days (may take as long as 12 days at times).
- One egg laid per day after nest complete (5 eggs first clutch usually).
- Female begins to brood eggs when all are laid count this as first day of brooding.
- Female broods eggs for 12-14 days. Babies hatch all on same day.
- Babies fledge after 18 to 21 days (do not open box after 12<sup>th</sup> day of hatching).
- Male feeds fledglings for next two to three weeks.

## **SECOND NEST**

- Female builds second nest about 5 days after first brood has fledged.
- Egg laying, brooding, and fledging follows as above.
- First group of fledglings may help feed second brood.

## **THIRD NEST**

May occur if there is adequate food and time.
