

## Dutchman's Breeches



**Bloom:** April-May

**ID Tip:** Flower resembles a pair of pants. Leaves are divided.

## Perfoliate Bellwort



**Bloom:** March-April

**ID Tip:** Yellow flowers hang downwards in a twisted fashion.

## Trilliums



**Bloom:** March-Early April

**ID Tip:** Three large leaves. Flower color has variations of white or wakerobin, yellow, red and painted

## Spring Ephemerals

Spring Ephemerals are best described as native woodland wildflowers that bloom early in the spring. As early bloomers, they cover the forest floor taking advantage of the sunlight from above, before the trees above them leaf out for the year. These delicate and unique wildflowers avoid competition with tree species by flowering in late March through May. They come in a variety of colors, shapes and sizes.

## Spring Beauty



**Bloom:** March-April

**ID Tip:** Can vary from white to pink petals. Leaves are grass-like.

## Trout Lily



**Bloom:** March-mid-April

**ID Tip:** Yellow petals that open in morning and close at night. Leaves have signature dark

## Reu Anemone



**Bloom:** Late March-April

**ID Tip:** White to pinkish flowers. Multiple yellow stamens. Leaves are smooth and three-lobed.

## Bloodroot



**Bloom:** March-April (only blooms for a few days)

**ID Tip:** Large white flowers with yellow anthers. Leaves kidney bean shaped and lobed.

## Phlox



**Bloom:** April-Early Summer

**ID Tip:** Bright pink-purple flowers in clusters. Will have 5 petals while Dame's Rocket only has 4 petals.

## Wood Anemone



**Bloom:** April-May

**ID Tip:** 5 sepals (no true petals), compared to the Reu, which has multiple. Leaves have jagged edges.

## Hepatica



**Bloom:** March-April

**ID Tip:** Can vary from white to blue/purple petals. Three-lobed leaves that resemble shape of human liver.

## Wild Geranium



**Bloom:** April-Early Summer

**ID Tip:** Light to deep purple petals. Leaves are shaped like a palm with lobes.

## Dwarf Larkspur



**Bloom:** April-May

**ID Tip:** Blue-purple flowers bloom quickly.
