

Design Your Own Wildlife Superhero

Most animals have unique adaptations that enable them to survive in nature.

In the space below, or on a separate sheet of paper, design your very own *super animal*. Choose an adaptation for its head, body, arms and legs. Afterwards, name your creature and describe what makes it a wildlife superhero. Below are just a few examples of animal adaptations for the head, body and arms/legs. You can choose from the examples or create your own.

HEAD

- * Great sense of smell like a black bear
- * Tongue like a snake to smell, detect sound and maneuver around
- * Eyes that can see long distances like a hawk
- * Eyes with a second eyelid like googles (beaver)
- * A sharp beak for capturing prey or drilling into wood to find food.
- * Create your own.

BODY

- * Camouflaged fur or feathers
- * Scales to protect it from rough or hard surfaces
- * A unique pattern like a skunk to scare predators
- * Waterproof fur like a beaver or river otter
- * Slimy skin like a salamander or frog to get away from predators quickly
- * Create your own.

ARMS & LEGS

- * Hooves
- * Sharps Claws
- * Wings for flying (what kind?)
- * Legs that can jump far like a frog
- * Webbed feet
- * Legs built for running long distances
- * Create your own.
