

# Occoneechee Marina Information

## 51 Total Marina Slips (all with water and electric service)

- 6 Transient slips for campers and cabin guests (one handicapped accessible)
- 24 Twenty-foot slips with 20 amp electric service (2 handicapped accessible)
- 18 Thirty-foot slips with 20 amp electric service
- 3 Thirty-foot slips with dual 20 and 30 amp electric service

## Annual Slip Rentals

- The park will accept applications for annual rentals through February 15 of each year.
- Applications available at eh park or on the internet; [www.virginiastateparks.gov](http://www.virginiastateparks.gov)
- Rental period will be March 1 to last day of February of each year.
- Applications will be selected by random drawing for each type of slip
- Payment of annual slip fee and compliance with rules and regulations guarantees customer the opportunity to renew slip rental annually. The Park will decide if additional rental renewals will be available based on public demand for slips.
- In the event that demand exceeds supply the Park will maintain a waiting list of applicants and by random drawing select new applicants by March 1 of each year.
- Pro rated and monthly fees available for slips not rented on an annual basis.

## Fuel Dock and Marine Pump Out

- Located near boat ramp, at boat rental area
- All fuel sales “pay-at-the-pump”
- Ethanol-free gasoline
- Marine pump out available to the public and marina renters.

## Marina Rates

### 20' with water and 20 amp hookup

20/20: \$1,200.00 + tax – 1 year

20/20: \$120 + tax (10% of yearly rate) – Per Month

### 30' with water and 20 amp hookup

30/20: \$1,600.00 + tax – 1 year

30/20: \$160 + tax (10% of yearly rate) – Per Month

### 30/50 with water and both 20 amp hookup and 30 amp hookup

30/50: \$1,750.00 + tax – 1 year

30/50: \$175 + tax (10% of yearly rate) – Per Month

Marine Pump-Out Fee: \$5:00 + tax

Transient Boat Slip: \$18.00 + tax per night (For overnight guests only)

Cancellation Fee: The cancellation fee for a **seasonal slip** rental is **three months rental**. Also, after the first of the month, that month is considered to be “used”.
